- › Every year, the **Art and Social Commitment Symposium** is an opportunity to meet and listen to **inspiring personalities from the artistic, nonprofit, academic, activist, and scientific worlds**. Among past invited speakers are Lina Lapelyte, Barthélémy Toguo, Thomas Hirschhorn, Tomás Saraceno, representatives of non-profit organizations such as Bill Shipsey (Founder of Art for Amnesty), or Céline Schmitt (Spokesperson for the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees). But also committed figures such as Camille Étienne, author Leïla Slimani, poet Abd Al Malik, or Augustin Trapenard for Libraries Without Borders, etc.
- › For the 2nd consecutive year, Thanks for Nothing highlights the voices of young activists by dedicating 1 hour of intervention on the stage of the Louvre Museum Auditorium, alongside recognized personalities from the art and nonprofit worlds.
- › Applications are thus open to **high school students, students, young professionals, volunteers, and activists...**
- › Applications must be submitted no later than **Sunday, July 14th, 2024, 11 PM**. The written presentation of the actions carried out by each individual must fit on **1 page**. Applications will be reviewed and selected by the Thanks for Nothing team.
- › Finalists must be available on **Thursday, September 26th, 2024**, no later than 1 PM for a 3-minute presentation per project at the Auditorium of the Louvre Museum.
- › Applications can be related to **any field of democracy**: human rights, rights of the living, access to culture, citizen participation, media issues, crisis management, diversity...
